<p><u>Oesophagogastroduodenoscopy, OGD</u> Diagnosis of upper gastrointestinal tract diseases such as gastritis, esophagitis, gastric ulcer or bleeding problems by gastroscop. Taking biopsies to investigate abnormalities' and DVD recording are carried out during OGD.</p> <p><u>Intra-gastric Balloon</u> Patients is first be sedated and a balloon with appropriate volume of saline is placed inside the stomach depending on patient's condition.</p>	<p>\$5,000</p> <p>Total Surgery Cost: Around \$30,000 – \$40,000</p> <p><u>Cost of room & equipment:</u> Around \$18,000 – 20,000</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Operation room - \$10K – \$12K • Intra-gastric balloon - \$8K – \$10K (Depends on material used) <p><u>Cost of doctor and anesthetist:</u> Around \$10,000 – \$20,000</p>	<p>Around 4 – 5 hours (Include waiting time and time for monitored anesthesia care) eg : Admit at 10am, and finish at 3pm.</p> <p>Around 30 minutes (Hospitalization is not necessary)</p>
